

## **Quick Install Guide**

This installation guide provides basic instructions for installing the DCS-56 Series Outdoor Enclosure. The DCS-56 series are outdoor enclosures designed for use with D-Link's box cameras. This IP66-certified enclosure protects your camera against dust and heavy jets of water. These models include a heater and a blower for a wider range of temperature-sensitive environments. The DCS-56 series consists of the DCS-56, the DCS-56P, and the DCS-56W.

## **Physical Installation**


**STEP 1:** Open the camera enclosure and slide the camera into the holder. Tighten the camera in the holder.






**STEP 3:** For the DCS-56 and DCS-56P models, Connect the Ethernet cable to the LAN port of the camera.

**Note**: Do not use the 12 V DC to power the camera via PoE.




<sup>12</sup> V DC to camera






For the DCS-56W model, connect the wireless antenna extender to the camera.

**STEP 2:** Adjust the holder by loosing the retaining screws and tighten the screws to lock the desired position.




Cable for extended wireless antenna DCS-56W **STEP 4:** Mount the mount bracket to the location where you want to set up your camera. To prevent damage to the Ethernet cable, pre-install the cable to the location.

**STEP 7:** To install the wireless antennas (DCS-56W only), connect the wireless antennas to the camera enclosure, then attach the antenna holders to the enclosure, and tighten them in place.



**STEP 5:** Install the camera enclosure onto the mount bracket and secure the joint with the screws provided.



**STEP 6:** Adjust the screws accordingly below the camera enclosure to control the camera position.
